Potential applicants:

- Doctoral candidates (during the last year of the doctorate)
- Postdoctoral researchers
- Junior group leaders

Application:

Interested persons are welcome to apply by submitting the following documents to your local JRA coordinator:

- Completed application form (please download from the Cluster website)
- CV

Please contact your local JRA coordinator before submitting the application.

General guidelines:

- There is no legal claim to receive funding from this measure.
- Projects can be granted as long as funds from the JRA are made available.
- The applicant must be connected to Hearing4all.connects and have a valid contract or hold a scholarship at one of the Cluster Universities (UOL, MHH, LUH). The contract or scholarship must not expire before the end of the intended coaching sessions.
- This programme runs until the end of the funding period of the Cluster of Excellence. Funding beyond this date is impossible.
